### POSITION

*The Summer Camp Lead Instructor will lead the implementation of Black Girls CODE Summer Camp curriculum, teaching 25-30 young women ages 13-17 mobile app development, web development, etc., collaborating with Summer Camp Instructional Assistants, create and maintain a strong camp culture and promoting an inclusive collaborative camp environment. S/he will thrive working in a fast-paced, high-performance environment and will demonstrate flexibility to last minute modification if they arise. The Summer Camp Lead Instructor will effectively and eagerly create strong consistent camp culture, effectively facilitate lessons, build relationships with campers and work in collaboration with staff. **Only candidates with a background in engineering, science, or technology will be considered for this role.** The successful candidate will have direct experience teaching or coaching middle and/or high school students, with strong classroom management and community building skills. Will have extensive experience programming with several coding languages and demonstrates capabilities using technology tools to facilitate and teach coding (Keynote, PowerPoint, Prezi, Google Hangouts, Google Docs, email etc.). - Strong interpersonal skills and ability to work well in a team environment
