- Oversee and drive the expansion, implementation, evaluation, research, and continuous improvement of our Summer Programs and Code Clubs, while ensuring program alignment to organizational goals and objectives
- Supervise assigned program staff and manage team professional development initiatives.
- Codify program operational processes and operations to include program logistics, funding and support models, program budgeting and planning, corporate and community partner cultivation, etc.
- Participate in regional affinity groups and technology events, as appropriate, to enhance BGC's global impact and presence
- Work collaboratively with other Program Directors and cross-functionally to execute our organizational vision and strategy for inspiring and empowering young women of color to embrace technology as creators and innovators
- Utilize data to track and report program performance and progress and identify areas of improvement to promote organizational growth
